Requirements for the presentation of research papers:

- Those who are interested in presenting papers should send the complete work, indicating the general objectives, a summary of the theoretical and methodological analysis, the methodology employed, and the findings or expected results. In the case of business professionals, it is hoped that you can recount your experiences in your place of work.
- The papers should be sent to the following email address: <u>ene@pucesa.edu.ec</u>
- The papers must be sent by March 25th, 2019









- The papers should be a maximum of 15 pages, including references and bibliography. They should be sent in a Word format, with upper, lower, left and right margins of 2.5 cm, using single-spaced 12pt Arial font under APA norms.
- Every paper presented should include a cover page, which should contain the name and affiliation of the author(s) of the paper (up to a maximum of four per paper), area of study (pertaining to the aforementioned subject areas), email address and the title of the work. Names should not appear on all further pages. At the start of the text, up to six key words should be indicated, which will facilitate the categorization of the paper. The papers should be comprised of the following sections:
 - Cover page (title of the paper, authors, affiliations, email addresses and areas of study)
 - Summary or Abstract with key words
 - o Introduction (brief background information, problems, objectives, relevance)
 - o Development (literature review, methodology employed and results)
 - Conclusions
 - References/Bibliography
 - o Appendix, if required
 - From April 10th, 2019, the authors of the selected papers will be notified, at least one of whom will have to personally argue for the paper's subsequent publication
 - Languages of the forum: All of the papers and talks presented should be in Spanish, Portuguese or English
 - The accepted works will be published in the ISBN book *Perspectivas de los Negocios y Emprendimientos Andino* (Perspectives of Andean Business)

Deadline for registrations: April 10th, 2019

Registration cost:

- \$ 100.00 (one hundred American dollars) for professionals and general public
- \$ 80.00 (eighty American dollars) for teachers, researchers and alumni of PUCE
